



Team Alberta 2011 North American Indigenous Games Coach Application Form

The Indigenous Sport Council (Alberta) (**ISCA**) is calling for applications for Coach volunteer positions for Team Alberta attending the 2011 North American Indigenous Games.

- The 2011 NAIG will take place from July 10 – 17, 2011 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
- The Indigenous Sport Council (Alberta) is the recognized Province Aboriginal Sport Body that oversees the operations of Team Alberta.
- Team Alberta will be comprised of approximately 440 athletes, 90 coaches and 20 mission staff.
- Overall management, team operations and logistics will be overseen by the Chef de Mission, Assistant Chef de Mission, and Mission Staff as selected by **ISCA**.

COACH POSITION DESCRIPTION

- In conjunction with Chef de Mission, assigned Mission staff and respective Sport Managers, coaching staff are required to oversee all aspects of team selection, training, supervision, and guidance of athletes attending the Games.
- Coaching staff are required to abide by the policies; rules and regulations; and other guidelines handed down by ISCA through their affiliation with the NAIG Council and the respective Host Society.
- Coaching staff will consist of a Head Coach and a support staff as defined within the NAIG Sport Technical Package.

GENERAL ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Pre-Games:

- Assist with athlete identification, qualifying events and camps, and **athlete registration**.
- Provide ongoing athlete training and monitoring from selection to competition.

Games-time:

- Mentorship and evaluation.

Post-Games:

- Provide **ISCA** with an evaluation of all aspects of Team operations relating to coaching staff duties, responsibilities and general event overview.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Minimum Complete Level 2 certification in their respective sport
- Aboriginal Coaching Manual certification
- First Aid/CPR an asset
- Preference will be given to coaches/sport managers of Aboriginal descent (First Nation, Métis, Inuit)
