The North American Indigenous Games Council conducted a NAIG Council meeting June 29, 2010, via teleconference call. This meeting was called by the President Mr. Harold Joseph, in response to your letter dated June 28, 2010, which contained your withdrawal of the Hosting of the North American Indigenous Games, scheduled for July of 2011 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

The North American Indigenous Games Council passed a Motion unanimously with one abstention. The motion is as follows and after being sent to your organization there will be a press release informing the Native, First Nations, Métis, Inuit, Eskimo, Native Hawaiian, cities, towns, counties, states, Provincial and Federal Governments from Canada and the United States.

Motion:

The North American Indigenous Games Council accepts the letter from NAIG USA INC dated June 28, 2010 in which it formally notified the Council of their decision to withdraw from Hosting the 2011 North American indigenous Games in Milwaukee, Wisconsin USA.

The Council's decision was made with much misgiving that NAIG USA Inc has decided not to follow through on their commitment to host the 2011 games, understanding the damage that this decision may cause Indigenous youth and communities across USA and Canada.

The NAIG Council remains committed to the NAIG movement and will undertake a process to determine its options for the Youth of North America in response to the cancellation of the 2011 games.
